Launch into a Carpentry apprenticeship with enhanced knowledge and skills with this PAID Enhanced Pathways Program

Program Overview:

Participants will be required to **commit to full-time hours, five (5) days per week, over 13-weeks**, for training and work experience. This program is PAID (*in accordance with trainee award wages*) and includes:

- 10-weeks of training to obtain a Certificate I in Construction (CPC10111), **plus**
- Teaching elements from 5 accredited units determined as highly desirable by industry (*units will be recognised as prior learning in Carpentry apprenticeship*):
 - Install flooring systems (CPCCCA3003A)
 - Construct wall frames (CPCCCA3003A)
 - Erect and dismantle restricted height scaffolding (CPCCCM2008B)
 - Install exterior cladding (CPCCCA3017B)
 - Erect roof trusses (CPCCCA3006B), **plus**
- Additional training in Situational Safety Awareness, Wellness and Self-Care, Industrial Relations and Workplace Preparation **plus**
- Engagement with real industry representatives and employers, **plus**
- 3-weeks work placement in a Construction / Carpentry business, **plus**
- Support throughout program to help participants progress and transition into an apprenticeship.

Program Objectives:

The objective of this program is to:

- Enhance the knowledge, skills, and preparedness of Carpentry apprentices.
- Successfully transition program participants into full-time Carpentry apprenticeships through East Coast Apprenticeships (Group Training Organisation).
